Roca Sifter: Quick Start Guide

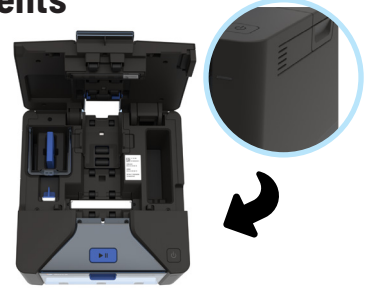
Unbox

- Remove the Roca Sifter from the box by gripping the bag and lifting it out.
- Place the Roca Sifter near an Ethernet jack or in an area with a strong Wi-Fi connection.



Unpack Components

- Open the lid by pressing the button on the right side of the Roca Sifter.
- Remove the power brick, power cord, card weight, and card hopper from inside the Roca Sifter.



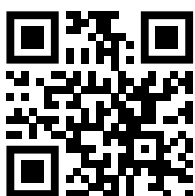
Connect Power

- Connect the **power cord** to the power brick, plug the barrel jack into the Roca Sifter, then plug the power cord into the outlet.
- The light on the front of the Roca Sifter will begin **flashing blue** and then **turn solid blue**.
- If the light does not flash blue automatically, press the **power button** on the top of the Roca Sifter to turn it on.



Connect to Internet

- You can connect by **Wi-Fi** or an **Ethernet cable**. If you have plugged in an Ethernet cable, skip the next three steps.
- To connect by Wi-Fi, press the setup button on the back of the Roca Sifter to put it into setup mode. The light will begin **flashing green**.
- Open the Wi-Fi settings on your phone or computer and connect to the Roca Sifter network. The network name will appear as: **Sifter-XXXXXXXXXXXX**
- Enter the **Wi-Fi default password** printed on the sticker inside the Roca Sifter.
- Scan the **QR code** or visit: **rocasetup.com**.
- Enter the password again on the setup website.
- Follow the prompts to connect the Roca Sifter to your Wi-Fi network.

Confirmation

- Wait for the front light to turn green and listen for the chime confirming the Roca Sifter is connected to the internet.
- Reconnect your phone or computer to your home or business Wi-Fi network and continue the setup process.
